

**RATIFY A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH BETHEL MISSIONARY
BAPTIST CHURCH FOR USE OF SPACE AT GRESHAM SCHOOL**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify a license agreement with Bethel Missionary Baptist Church for use of the Auditorium, Parking Lot and an Office at Gresham School, located at 8524 S. Green Street. A written license agreement for such use is currently being negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written license agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. USE: The auditorium, parking lot, an office and hallway fan room for storage of equipment, to be used for church services on Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

TERM: The term of this license agreement shall commence on September 1, 2004 and shall end August

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT: Either party shall have the right to terminate this agreement upon sixty (60) days prior written notice to the other.

LICENSE FEE: The annual license fee shall be \$9,600, payable in monthly installments of \$800.00, payable in advance, to Gresham School.

MAINTENANCE: Licensee shall maintain the premises in its present condition or better throughout the

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General – Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct these

investigations.

Conflicts – The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one-year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office
