

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL WASTE SERVICES
FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING SERVICES FOR ALL
CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS BUILDINGS**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

As a result of the review of the National Waste Services contract, the following decision is reported:

Contracting services for all Chicago Public Schools buildings to the Department of Operations at a cost of \$...

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION: The M/WBE goals for this contract include: 26% total MBE, 16% total African American, 7.5% total Hispanic, 2% total Asian and 5% total WBE.

However, the M/WBE Review Committee recommends that a portion of the M/WBE certification

goals for this contract as required by the Revised Remedial Plan be granted because the contract scope is not further divisible.
