APPROVE FINDINGS THAT PUPILS ARE NON-RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO NOT ENTITLED TO ATTEND THE CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON A TUITION-FREE BASIS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

That, the Chicago Board of Education: (a) adopt the December 5, 2007 findings of the Law Department that (i) the pupils (ID #45326365 and ID# 38007807) were non-residents of the City of Chicago not entitled to attend the Chicago Public Schools on a tuition-free basis; and (ii) the pupils' parent, as the person who enrolled the pupils, is indebted to the Board for non-resident tuition for the pupils' attendance in the Chicago Public Schools from September 2007 to June 2009 in the total amount of \$35,238.76 (\$8,809.69 for 2007-2008 for each pupil) (\$8,809.69 for 2008-2009 for each pupil); (b) reject any objections by the parent to the Law Department's findings; (c) bar the pupils from attending the Chicago
