**COMPENSATION:**

Consultant shall be paid as specified in the agreement; total not to exceed the sum of \$350,000.00 inclusive of all reimbursable expenses

**REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES:**


Consultant shall be reimbursed per diem and travel expenses including air fare, hotel and ground transportation for Teen the Trainer sessions hosted in Chicago
