Approve entering into an agreement with After School Matters to provide educational services and technology support to the Department of Arts Education at a cost not to exceed \$212,000.00. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis: the non-competitive request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement Review Committee on June 5, 2012, and was approved by the Chief Purchasing Officer on

June 12, 2012. A written agreement for educational services and technology support for the Advanced Arts Education Program (AAEP) at Gallery 37 is currently being negotiated. No services may be provided


