

APPROVE EXERCISING THE SECOND OPTION TO RENEW THE TEACHER REFERRAL AND SUPPORT AGREEMENT WITH TEACH FOR AMERICA

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve exercising the second option to renew the Teacher Referral and Support agreement with Teach for America to refer and support up to 325 provisionally-certified first-year teacher-interns to Chicago Public Schools and support up to 245 second-year teacher-interns at a total cost for the option period of \$1,587,500.00 (for a total of 570 teachers). A written document exercising this option is

currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Teach for America during the option period prior to execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event

12-month certification program and at the end of the program teacher-interns will be eligible for an Illinois Alternative Initial Teaching Certificate. TFA, working with partner Universities, will provide teacher-interns with all coursework and other necessary training in order to be professionally certified by the Illinois State Board of Education and eligible for hire by Chicago Public Schools. 
