APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GLOBAL WORKPLACE SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR LOGISTIC MANAGEMENT SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Global Workplace Solutions, LLC to provide Logistic Management Services to the Office of Strategy Management at a total cost not to exceed \$14,200,000. Vendor was selected on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7.2. A written

DELIVERABLES:

Vendor will implement the plan set forth by the Board and provide overall management and services to complete the relocation, removal of contents, furnishings and equipment and securing all schools affected as specified in the agreement that will be executed with the Board.

OUTCOMES:

Vendor's services will result in every student affected by a school action to be seamlessly integrated into his/her new school. The project seeks to foster a transitional environment that is positive, productive, and

successful and provide for maximum continuity.

COMPENSATION:

Vendor will be paid in accordance with the pricing set forth in the written agreement; total compensation not to exceed the sum of ~~\$14,200,000~~ 18,900,000.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted May 25, 2011 (11-0525-PO2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year
