**RESCIND WARNING RESOLUTION – JULIA HOCK  
TENURED TEACHER, ASSIGNED TO ARTHUR DIXON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

**TO THE CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

That the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (“Board”) rescind a Warning Resolution previously issued to Julia Hock on April 3, 2013, Board Report No. 13-0403-EX8.

A Warning Resolution was issued to Julia Hock at the April 3, 2013

meeting of the Board, Board Report No. 13-0403-EX8, informing her that she had violated Corrective Action Category “Performance: Negligence/Incompetence – Students,” which prohibits the “failure to act in the manner of a reasonably prudent educator in supervision of students” based on Julia Hock’s alleged failure to maintain supervision of students while transitioning from one classroom to the next.

Subsequent to the issuance of the Warning Resolution, Julia Hock sought administrative review with the Circuit Court of Cook County, Chancery Division, wherein it was determined that the student may have left school grounds prior to Julia Hock’s transport of students. On July 25, 2014, the
