**RESOLUTION REGARDING SCHOOL RATINGS AND ACCOUNTABILITY STATUSES
IN RESPONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)**

WHEREAS, there is an outbreak of respiratory illness caused by a novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and infections are being reported internationally, including the United States and the

City of Chicago;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the Health and Human Services Secretary, Alex M. Azar II, declared a public health emergency ("PHE") for the United States;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Trump declared a nationwide emergency under the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5121-5207) in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency under the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5121-5207) in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby directs as follows:

1. All schools normally eligible for school ratings under Board Report 10-0626-BOA will be denoted as

"Inability to Rate" for the 2020-2021 school year (ratings based on data from the 2019-2020 school year).

2. Each school that received Good Standing status, Remediation status (which indicates the need for

Provisional Support) or Probation status (which indicates the need for Intensive Support) per Section
