**AMEND BOARD REPORT 11-0427-PO1

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:**

That the Chicago Board of Education ("Board") amend the Charter School Capital and Facility Budget Policy, 11-0427-PO1. This Policy was subject to public comment from July 23, 2020 through August 17, 2020.

**POLICY TEXT:**

**I. Purpose and Goals**

The purpose is to ensure the Charter schools to which this policy applies are adequately and equitably funded. The Chicago Board of Education currently has granted or approved charters to forty-one ~~thirty-six~~ Charter Schools. ~~Thirteen~~ Twelve Charter Schools have the legal capacity to operate multiple campuses under a single charter agreement. As of the date of this amended

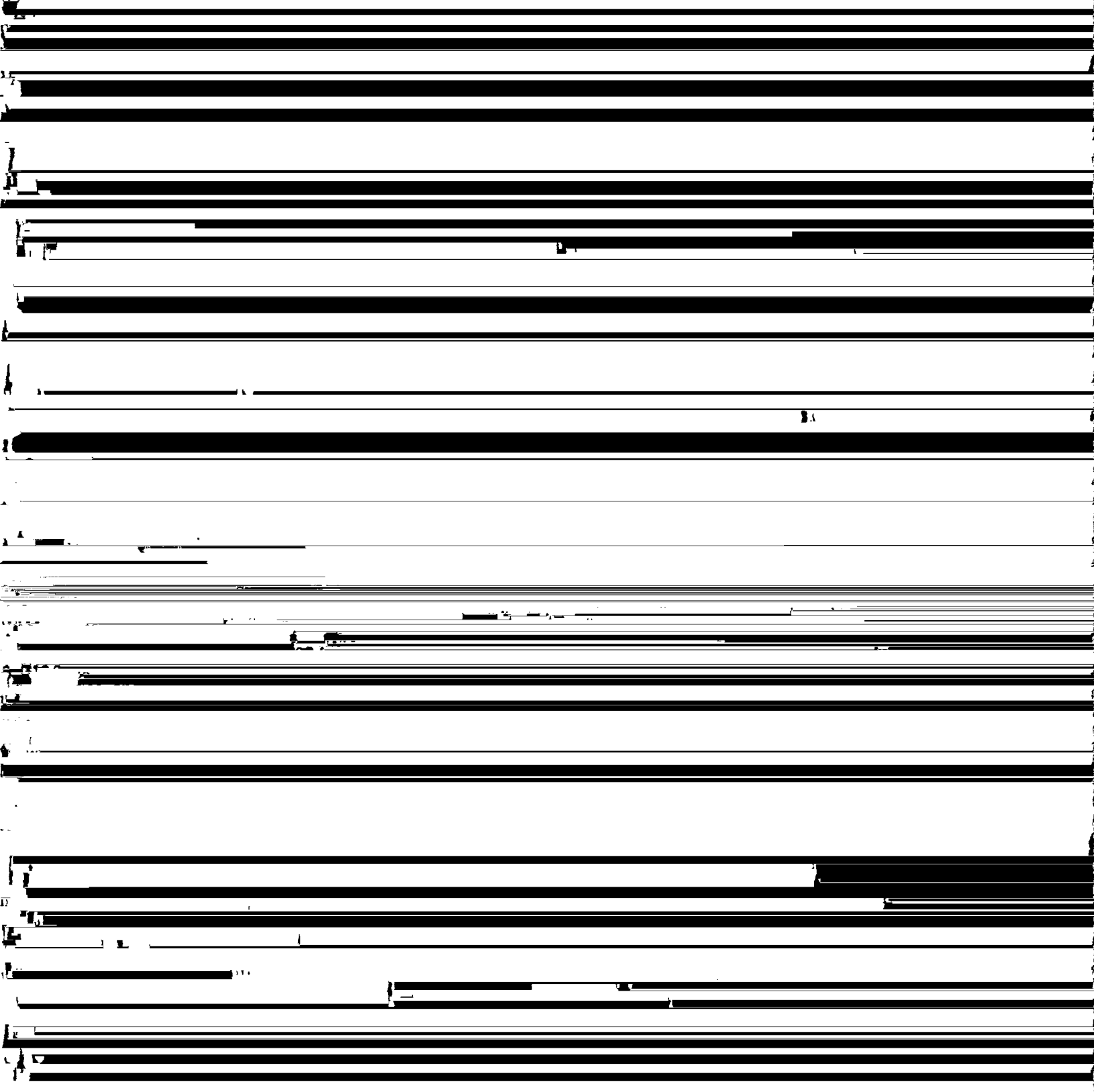
